STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT providing that the sheriff of Penobscot county shall not be entitled to a percentage of the fees of his deputies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The sheriff of Penobscot county shall not be 2 entitled to receive from his deputies any portion of their 3 fees for travel and service of precepts, nor any percentage 4 of any fees received by said deputies.
- Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this 2 act are hereby repealed.
 - Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
