IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT in relation to trustee process.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Clause six of section fifty-five of chapter
2 eighty-six of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by
3 inserting after the word "suit" at the end of the fifth line
4 the words 'for taxes or' so that said clause shall read as
5 follows:

‘VI. By reason of any amount due from him to the
7 principal defendant, as wages for his personal labor, or
8 that of his wife or minor children, for a time not exceeding
9 one month next preceding the service of the process, and
10 and not exceeding twenty dollars of the amount due to him

11 as wages for his personal labor ; and this is not exempt in
12 any suit for taxes or for necessities furnished him or his
13 family ; moreover, wages of minor children and of women,
14 are not, in any case, subject to trustee process on account
15 of any debt of parent or husband.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
