STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend Section 1 of Chapter 102 of the Public
Laws of 1895, relation to the incorporation and control of
Gas and Electric Companies.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1 of chapter 102 of the Public Laws of 1895 is
2 hereby amended by striking out from the end of said sec-
3 tion, the following words, “without the consent of such
4 other company, person or firm” so that said section as
5 amended, shall read as follows:

‘Section 1. Corporations for the purpose of making,
7 generating, selling, distributing and supplying gas or

8 electricity, or both, for lighting, heating, manufacturing
9 or mechanical purposes, in any city or town or two or
10 more adjoining cities or towns within this state, or for
11 either or any of such purposes, may be organized under
12 the provisions of sections sixteen, seventeen, eighteen,
13 nineteen and twenty of chapter forty-eight of the Revised
14 Statutes of this state, and acts amendatory thereof and
15 additional thereto and all provisions of said chapter and
16 acts are hereby made applicable to such corporations.
17 But no corporation organized hereunder shall have author-
18 ity, without special act of the legislature, to make, gener-
19 ate, sell, distribute or supply gas or electricity or both,
20 for any purpose, in or to any city or town, in or to which
21 another company, person or firm are making, generating,
22 selling, distributing or supplying, or are authorized to
23 make, generate, sell, distribute or supply gas or electricity
24 or both.'
