

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of paying the unexpired Licenses of Hawkers and Peddlers.

Resolved. That the treasurer of state be and hereby is auth2 orized and directed to pay to each and every person holding
3 a state license as hawker and peddler, issued by the secretary
4 of state prior to May twentieth, 1900, such an amount as the
5 proportion of the unexpired time of such license subsequent
6 to May twentieth, 1900, bears to the whole time for which
7 such license was issued. And that the sum of eighteen
8 hundred dollars be and hereby is appropriated out of any
9 funds in the treasury, not otherwise appropriated, for the
10 purpose of this resolve. Provided, however, that those re11 ceiving from the state any amount on account of unexpired
12 licenses by virtue of special resolves finally passed and ap13 proved before the approval of this resolve, shall receive noth14 ing in addition.
