STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend chapter 137 of the Public Laws of 1887, as amended by chapter 313 of the Public Laws of 1893, and as further amended by chapter 330 of the Public Laws of 1897, relating to service of subpoenas issued by disclosure commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 5, of chapter 137 of the Public Laws of 1887, as
2 amended by chapter 313 of the Public Laws of 1893, and as
3 further amended by chapter 330 of the Public Laws of 1897,
4 is hereby further amended by striking out all of said section
5 five and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

'Sect. 5. The subpoena may be served by any officer qualified
7 to serve civil process in said county by giving to the debtor
8 in hand a certified copy of the petition and subpoena, which
9 said service shall be at least twenty-four hours before the
10 time of said disclosure for every twenty miles travel from his
11 home or place of abode at the time of service to the place of
12 disclosure.'
