STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to authorize the Damariscotta Gas Light Company to
supply gas at Damariscotta and Newcastle.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Damariscotta Gas Light Company, a corpo-
2 ration organized under the provisions of sections sixteen,
3 seventeen, eighteen, nineteen and twenty of chapter forty-
4 eight of the Revised Statutes, and acts amendatory thereof
5 and additional thereto, is hereby authorized to make, gen-
6 erate, sell, distribute and supply gas, for lighting, heating,
7 manufacturing and mechanical purposes in the towns of
8 Damariscotta and Newcastle, with all the powers and privi-
9 leges granted to and subject to all the duties imposed upon
10 corporations organized for such purposes under said general
11 laws.

Sect. 2. Said corporation is authorized to issue its bonds on
2 such rates and time and in such amounts as it may deem
3 expedient and secure the same by appropriate mortgages upon
4 its franchises and property.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
