STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to provide in part for the Expenditures of Govern-
ment for the year nineteen hundred and three.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. In order to provide for the several acts and
2 resolves of the legislature, requiring the payment of
3 money from the treasury, and also to provide for the neces-
4 sary expenditures of government for the current fiscal year
5 of nineteen hundred and three, the following sums are
6 hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury, and
7 the governor, with the advice and consent of the council, is
8 authorized at any time prior to the first day of January next,
9 to draw his warrant on the treasury for the same.
