STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to provide in part for the Expenditures of Government for the year nineteen hundred and three.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. In order to provide for the several acts and
- 2 resolves of the legislature, requiring the payment of
- 3 money from the treasury, and also to provide for the neces-
- 4 sary expenditures of government for the current fiscal year
- 5 of nineteen hundred and three, the following sums are
- 6 hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury, and
- 7 the governor, with the advice and consent of the council, is
- 8 authorized at any time prior to the first day of January next,
- 9 to draw his warrant on the treasury for the same.
