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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

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AN ACT in relation to the powers of the Union River Light,  
Gas and Power Company.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section 1. The organization of the Union River Light,  
2 Gas & Power Company, a corporation organized at Ells-  
3 worth, Hancock county, Maine, under the general laws of  
4 said State of Maine, for the purposes set forth in its certifi-  
5 cate of organization approved by the attorney general of said  
6 State of Maine, October 6, A. D. 1902, and the right of said  
7 company to carry out such purposes, except in the towns of  
8 Mount Desert and Tremont, are hereby ratified, approved and  
9 confirmed.

Sect. 2. Said company is hereby authorized and empowered  
2 to issue its bonds for the carrying out of any of its purposes  
3 as named in said certificate of organization and in this act  
4 prescribed, except in the towns of Mount Desert and Tre-  
5 mont, to an amount not exceeding the sum of one million  
6 dollars, on such rates and time as it may deem expedient, and  
7 to secure the payment of the principal and interest on such  
8 bonds by appropriate mortgages or deeds of trust of all or  
9 any part of its property, franchises, rights and privileges now  
10 owned, or to be hereafter acquired by it.

Sect. 3. Upon the consent of the Bar Harbor Electric Light  
2 Company being obtained, said Union River Light, Gas &  
3 Power Company may carry out the purposes set forth in its  
4 said certificate of organization in said towns of Mount Desert  
5 and Tremont.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
