STATE OF MAINE,

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to provide for the representation of the State of Maine at the Louisiana Purchase Exposition at St. Louis, Missouri, and making an appropriation therefor.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. The sum of fifty thousand dollars, or so much 2 thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated out of the 3 moneys in the treasury for the purpose of exhibiting at the 4 Louisana Purchase Exposition, at St. Louis, Missouri, the 5 various agricultural, manufacturing, industrial and vacation 6 resources of the State; which money shall be paid by the 7 treasurer upon warrants of the governor, issued upon a 8 requisition, signed by the chairman of the commission 9 appointed by the governor, under chapter 217, of the Resolves 10 of 1901.

Sect. 2. Said commission shall have charge of the interests 2 of the State of Maine and its citizens, in the collection, prep-3 aration and exhibition at said exposition of the various inter-4 ests and resources of this State, illustrating its history, 5 progress, moral and material welfare, growth, enterprise and 6 development and all other matters, tending to advance the 7 interests or reputation and prosperity of this State at said 8 exhibition; it shall collect, obtain and disseminate through-9 out the State all necessary information, regarding the said 10 exposition; secure the co-operation of the various interests II of the several counties of the State in promoting the objects 12 of the exposition; and in general have and exercise full 13 authority in relation to the participation of the State of Maine 14 and its citizens in the Louisiana Purchase Exposition, includ-15 ing the planning and construction of a suitable Maine State 16 building which shall contain official headquarters of the 17 State, and furnishing and maintaining the same.

Sect. 3. The members of the commission shall receive no 2 compensation for their services but shall be entitled to the 3 actual necessary expenses incurred while in discharge of 4 duties imposed upon them by the commission. Said compission shall have power to employ and fix the compensation 6 of its secretary and to employ such agents and assistants as 7 may be necessary; said commission shall continue in office 8 until it shall have completed and settled the business connected therewith; all vacancies in said commission which 10 occur by death, resignation or otherwise shall be filled by 11 the governor.

Sect. 4. After the Louisiana Purchase Exposition shall 2 have been closed the said commission is hereby authorized to 3 sell or otherwise dispose of the buildings and property of 4 the State of Maine then on the exposition grounds at St. 5 Louis, deposit the moneys received therefor in the State

- 6 treasury and any money in possession of the said commis-
- 7 sion belonging to the State shall be paid to the State treasurer.
 - Sect. 5. The commission shall as requested by the governor
- 2 from time to time, render to him reports of its proceedings.
 - Sect. 6. This act shall take effect when approved.
