IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend Section fifteen of Chapter fifteen of Revised Statutes of Maine, 1883, relating to Burying-Grounds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section fifteen of Revised Statutes of Maine, 1883, is hereby 2 amended by inserting in the second line thereof, after the word 3 "securities," the words: 'or deposited in savings banks.' So 4 that said section as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 15. Every trust fund authorized by the preceding 6 section shall be safely invested in United States, state, county, 7 city or town securities, or deposited in savings banks; and the 8 annual income only, shall be expended in performance of the 9 requirements of the trust.'
