STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to fix the salary of the judge of probate for Hancock county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. On and after the first day of January in the year 2 of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and three, the salary 3 of the judge of probate for Hancock county shall be thirteen 4 hundred dollars a year instead of the sum now established 5 by law.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
