STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend section twenty-nine of chapter eighteen of the Revised Statutes, relating to ways across station grounds of railroads.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section twenty-nine of chapter eighteen of the Revised 2 Statutes is hereby amended so that the same shall read as 3 follows:

'Sect. 29. No way shall be laid out through or across any 5 land or right of way of any railroad corporation, used for 6 station purposes, unless after notice and hearing the railroad 7 commissioners adjudge that public convenience and necessity

8 require it. When the tribunal having jurisdiction over the

9 laying out of such way is satisfied, after hearing, that public 10 convenience and necessity require such laying out, such pro11 ceedings shall be suspended and petition filed by such tribunal 12 with the railroad commissioners for their adjudication here13 under.'
