STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to set off part of Reed plantation, and annex the same
to Drew plantation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. All that part of Reed plantation in the county of
2 Aroostook, lying north of the Mattawamkeag river and west
3 of the Wytopotlock stream and south of the county boundary
4 line as existing prior to one thousand eight hundred and
5 eighty-nine as per chapter 514 of acts and resolves of 1889,
6 said county line being an extension of the northerly boundary
7 line of the town of Kingman in the county of Penobscot, is
8 hereby set off from said Reed plantation and annexed to Drew
9 plantation in said county of Penobscot.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
