IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and forty-five of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, entitled, "An Act to provide sewerage in the town of Houlton."


Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section two of said act is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sect. 2. Said corporation may acquire and hold real and

- 3 personal estate necessary and convenient for the purposes
- 4 aforesaid, not exceeding in amount one hundred thousand
- ${\bf 5}$ dollars; may sell and convey the same; may issue certificates
- 6 of stock to an amount not exceeding the amount of its capital
- 7 stock actually paid in; and may issue and sell bonds to an

8 amount not exceeding fifty thousand dollars, to aid in the 9 construction, repairs and improvements of its works, and said 10 bonds to the amount of fifty thousand dollars may be pur11 chased and held by the savings banks of Maine.'
