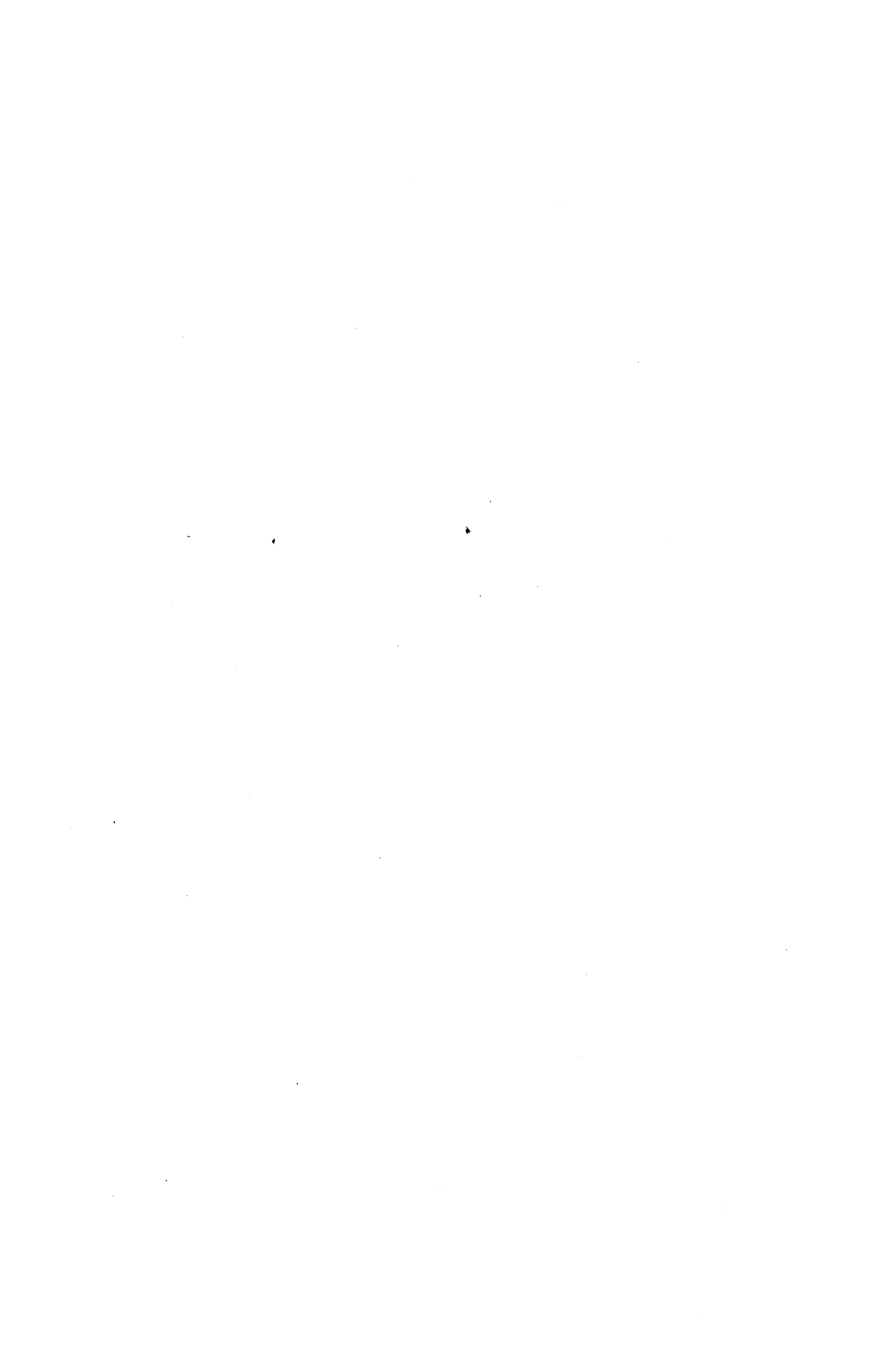
AN ACT to extend the charter of the Eastport Bridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The charter incorporating certain persons for the
2 purpose of building a bridge uniting the towns of Eastport
3 and Perry, passed June twenty-seventh, eighteen hundred and
4 twenty, being chapter fourteen of the Private and Special
5 Laws of eighteen hundred and twenty, and the right to take
6 toll thereunder, which charter was extended for two years,
7 by an act approved March twenty-sixth, eighteen hundred
8 and ninety-five, being chapter two hundred and eighty-three
9 of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and
10 ninety-five, and was again extended for six years, by an act
11 approved March tenth, eighteen hundred and ninety-seven,

12 being chapter four hundred and fifteen of the Private and
13 Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-seven, are
14 hereby extended for the term of six years, from September
15 twentieth, nineteen hundred and three; provided, that the rate
16 of tolls to be charged and collected shall not exceed those now
17 charged and collected.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
