## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

---

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and twenty-seven of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty, entitled "An act to supply the people of Houlton with pure water," as amended by chapter four hundred and ninety-seven of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-nine.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section one of said chapter two hundred and 2 twenty-seven is hereby amended by adding thereto at the end 3 of the said section the following: 'And for the purpose of 4 providing the town and village of Houlton a system of public 5 sewers and drainage, for the comfort, convenience and health 6 of the people of said Houlton.'

Sect. 2. Section two of said chapter two hundred and 2 twenty-seven as amended by chapter four hundred and ninety-

3 seven of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred  
4 and eighty-nine is hereby amended to read as follows:

5 'Said corporation may acquire and hold real and per-  
6 sonal estate, necessary and convenient for the purposes  
7 aforesaid, and the stock in whole or in part of the Houlton  
8 Sewerage Company, not exceeding in all two hundred thou-  
9 sand dollars; may sell and convey the same; may issue cer-  
10 tificates of stock to an amount not exceeding fifty thousand  
11 dollars; and may issue and sell bonds to an amount not  
12 exceeding one hundred thousand dollars; to aid in the con-  
13 struction, extension, improvement and repairs of its works,  
14 and to pay any existing debts whether represented by bonds,  
15 notes or accounts, and for the purchase of the whole or any  
16 part of the stock of the Houlton Sewerage Company; and  
17 said bonds to the amount of one hundred thousand dollars  
18 may be purchased and held by the savings banks of Maine.'
