STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter fifty-two of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-five relating to the salary of the Register of Probate for the county of Penobscot.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assemblea, as follows

Section 1. Chapter fifty-two of the Public Laws of eighteen

- 2 hundred and ninety-five is hereby amended as follows: By
- 3 striking out in the third line after the words "salary of," the
- 4 word "thirteen," and inserting in its place after said words
- 5 "salary of," the word 'fifteen,' so that said section as amended,
- 6 shall read as follows:

'Section I. From and after January I, eighteen hundred 8 and ninety-five, the register of probate for the county of 9 Penobscot shall receive an annual salary of fifteen hundred 10 dollars, and an additional allowance of eight hundred dollars 11 for clerk hire; said salary and allowance to be paid from the 12 county treasury and to be instead of the salary and fees now 13 provided by law, and all fees now received by said register as 14 register of probate or register of insolvency shall be paid by 15 said register into the county treasury for the use of the county.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
