STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter 25 of the Private and Special Laws of 1899, relating to taking eels in Bagaduce river, bay and tributaries.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1, chapter 25 of the Private and Special Laws of 2 1899, is hereby amended by striking out in the fourth and 3 fifth lines the words "first day of April and first day of 4 November" and inserting therein the words, 'fifteenth day of 5 April and the first day of February,' so that said section as 6 amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 1. It shall be unlawful to take or fish for any eels 8 in any manner whatever in the Bagaduce river, Bagaduce

9 bay or any of the tributaries of said river or bay between the
10 fifteenth day of April and the first day of February of each
11 year.'
