IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Lewiston, Brunswick &
Bath Street Railway.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The locations of the rails, posts, wires and fix-
tures of the Lewiston & Auburn Horse Railroad Company,
the Bath Street Railway and of the Lewiston, Brunswick &
Bath Street Railway in the streets, roads and ways of Auburn,
Lewiston, Webster, Lisbon, Topsham, Brunswick, West Bath
and Bath are hereby confirmed and made valid.

Sect. 2. The said Lewiston, Brunswick & Bath Street Rail-
way is hereby authorized to sell or lease its property and
franchises to any street railroad company whose lines as con-

4 structured or chartered would form connecting or continuous
5 lines with the lines of the said Lewiston, Brunswick & Bath
6 Street Railway as constructed or chartered, and in such case
7 the corporation so purchasing or leasing said property and
8 franchises shall be entitled to all the privileges and be sub-
9 ject to all appropriate conditions and limitations contained in
10 the charter and franchises of the said Lewiston, Brunswick
11 & Bath Street Railway. Any street railroad whose lines as
12 constructed or chartered would form connecting or contin-
13 uous lines with the lines of the said Lewiston, Brunswick &
14 Bath Street Railway as constructed or chartered is hereby
15 authorized to so purchase or lease the property and franchises
16 of the said Lewiston, Brunswick & Bath Street Railway.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
