STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Home for Aged Men in
Portland.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Home for Aged Men in Portland, a corporation organized under the provisions of chapter one hundred and thirty-three of the Private and Special Laws of 1881, amended by chapter two hundred and sixty-seven of the Private and Special Laws of 1883, is authorized and empowered for the purposes of its organization, to receive, take and hold, by deed, devise, bequest, or otherwise, and sell, exchange, convey, or otherwise dispose of, property, real and personal, to the amount of five hundred thousand dollars, including all gifts, conveyances, devises and bequests heretofore made to said corporation.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
