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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

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AN ACT to amend section thirty of chapter four hundred and fifty of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-three, incorporating the city of Eastport.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section thirty of chapter four hundred and fifty  
2 of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and  
3 ninety-three is hereby amended by striking out in Paragraph  
4 IV. all after the word "marshal," and inserting in lieu thereof  
5 the words 'who shall exercise all the powers and be subject  
6 to the duties prescribed for constables by the laws of the  
7 State'; so that said Paragraph IV., as amended, shall read as  
8 follows:

'IV. A city marshal who shall exercise all the powers and  
10 be subject to the duties prescribed for constables by the laws  
11 of the State.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
