STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT establishing the Salary of the County Treasurer of
the County of York.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. From and after the first day of January, in the
2 year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and three, the
3 salary of the county treasurer of the county of York shall
4 be seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$750.00) annually,
5 payable quarterly on the last days of March, June, September
6 and December, which shall be in full for all services, expenses
7 and travel.

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this
2 act are hereby repealed.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
