STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT amendatory of chapter two hundred seventy-nine of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and one, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Matagamon Manufacturing Company."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section nine of chapter two hundred seventy-
2 nine of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred
3 and one is hereby amended by striking out the words "five
4 hundred thousand" in the second line thereof, and inserting
5 in place thereof the words 'one million,' so that said section
6 as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 9. The capital stock of said company shall not exceed
8 one million dollars, divided into shares of one hundred dol-

9 lars each. And for the purpose of carrying out any of the
10 provisions for which said company is incorporated, it is
11 hereby authorized and empowered to issue its bonds in such
12 form and amount and on such time and rates as it may deem
13 expedient, not exceeding the amount of its capital stock act-
14 ually subscribed for, and secure the same by mortgage of its
15 property and franchises.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
