STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter 64 of the Private and Special Laws of 1899 as amended by chapter 472 of the Private and Special Laws of 1901, relating to the Wilson Stream Dam Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The organization of the Wilson Stream Dam 2 Company, a corporation chartered by a special act of the 3 Legislature, chapter 64 of the Private and Special Laws of 4 1899, as amended by chapter 472 of the Private and Special 5 Laws of 1901, the certificate of which organization was filed 6 in the office of the secretary of state, December 17, 1902, is 7 hereby ratified and confirmed, and all acts of said corporation

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8 done in pursuance of said charter and amendment, are hereby9 made valid and legal.

Sect. 2. And said charter is hereby further amended by 2 striking out all of section 4 of said chapter 64 of the Private 3 and Special Laws of 1899, and inserting the following: 'Said 4 corporation in addition to the powers already conferred upon 5 it, is hereby further authorized and empowered at all times 6 to store and hold, by means of the dams mentioned in said 7 original charter and said amendment, water for all domestic, 8 sanitary, manufacturing, industrial, municipal and commer-9 cial purposes, and said corporation can use said water for any 10 and all said purposes, and to create power for any and all II such purposes, and said corporation can in any manner sell, 12 lease, or otherwise dispose of, the use of said water for any 13 and all such purposes, or to create power for any and all such 14 purposes, to any person, party or corporation, municipal or 15 otherwise. Provided, however, the water stored in said dams 16 shall be used at all times so far as necessary for log driving 17 purposes on said Wilson stream.
