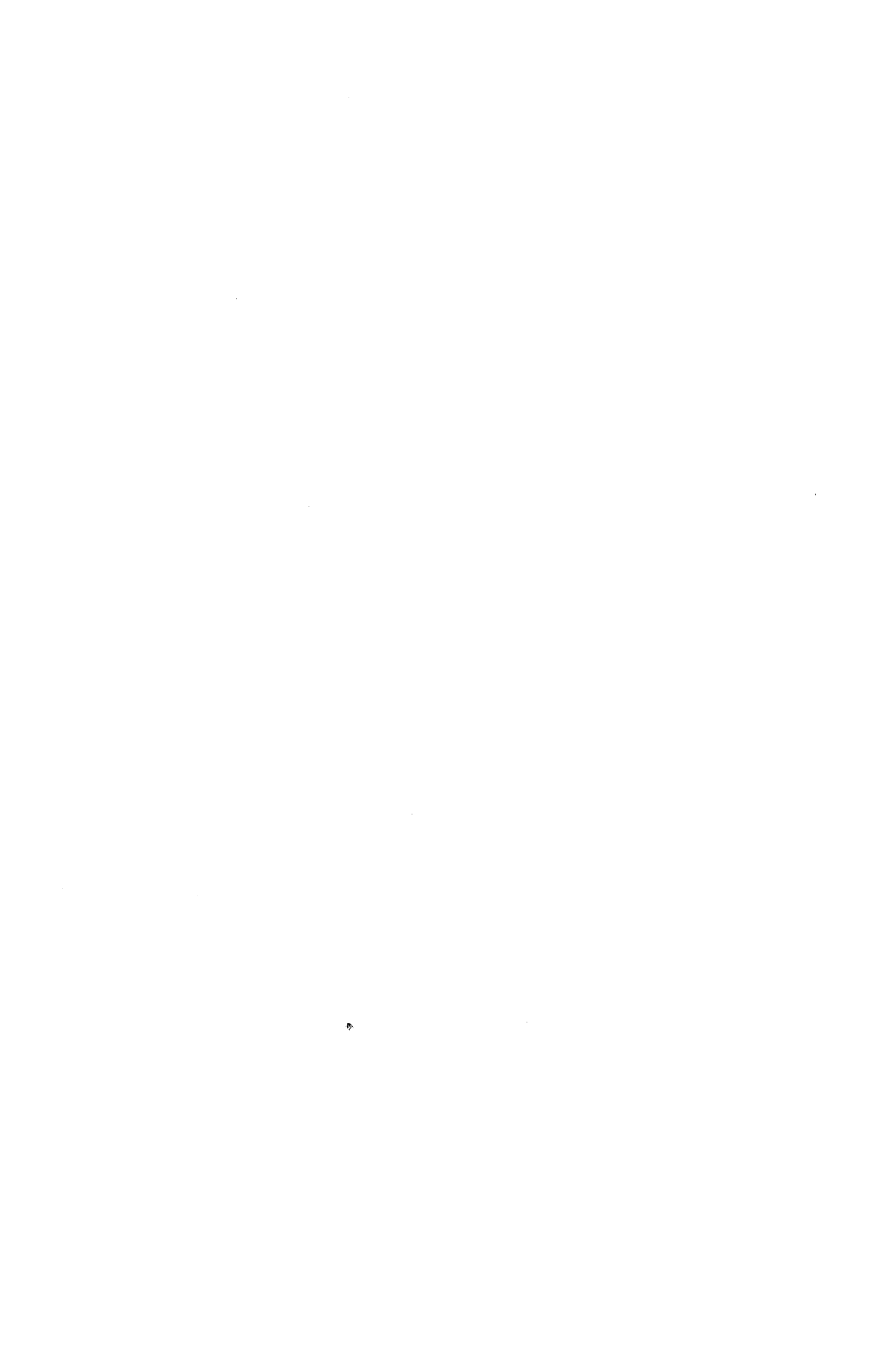
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to change the name of the town of Saint Agatha, in
the county of Aroostook, to Cleveland.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The name of the town of Saint Agatha, in the
2 county of Aroostook, is hereby changed to Cleveland, and
3 said town shall be hereafter known as Cleveland. This
4 change of name shall not in any way affect, alter, modify or
5 change the corporate duties, rights or liabilities of said town
6 or its officers.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
