STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT amend section 5 of chapter 42 of the Public Laws of 1899, as amended by chapter 326 of the Private and Special Laws of 1901, relating to fishing through the ice in Thompson pond.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. So much of section 5 of chapter 42 of the Public
2 Laws of 1899, as amended by chapter 326 of the Private and
3 Special Laws of 1901, as prohibits fishing through the ice in
4 Thompson pond, situated partly in Oxford and partly in
5 Cumberland county, in accordance with the general law of
6 the State, permitting fishing through the ice during Feb-
7 ruary, March and April, is hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
