STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT additional to and amendatory of chapter 54 of the Private and Special Laws of 1895 creating the Rumford Falls Village Corporation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The limits of the Rumford Falls Village Corpo-

- 2 ration as described in section I of chapter 54 of the Private
- 3 and Special Laws of 1895 are hereby extended and enlarged
- 4 by adding thereto the following described land in the town
- 5 of Rumford together with all the inhabitants and property
- 6 thereon. Viz: All the land that is located on the northerly
- 7 side of the Androscoggin river in the town of Rumford,
- 8 above Rumford Falls, which was known as the Charles F.

- 9 Wheeler farm, said farm being situated between the south-10 erly and westerly line of the Rufus Virgin farm, so called, 11 and the farm owned by William M. Blanchard and now 12 occupied by his son George E. Blanchard.
- Sect. 2. All the provisions of chapter 54 referred to in 2 section I of this act shall apply to all the land, inhabitants and 3 property on the same, described in section I of this act the 4 same as if said land, inhabitants and property had been 5 described and included in section I of said chapter 54. And 6 the same shall become a part of the Rumford Falls Village 7 Corporation from and after the date of the approval of this 8 act.
