IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to abolish chapter 282, Public Laws of 1868, relating to taking fish in Frenchmans bay except by the ordinary process of fishing with hook and line.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, chapter 582 of the Public 2 Laws of 1868 is hereby repealed.
