AN ACT to abolish chapter 282, Public Laws of 1868,  
relating to taking fish in Frenchmans bay except by the  
ordinary process of fishing with hook and line.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, chapter 582 of the Public  
2 Laws of 1868 is hereby repealed.
