STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to authorize the Augusta, Winthrop & Gardiner Railway to supply electricity in the towns of Winthrop and Manchester.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Augusta, Winthrop & Gardiner Rail-2 way is hereby authorized to make, generate, sell, distribute 3 and supply electricity for lighting, heating, manufacturing 4 and mechanical purposes in the towns of Winthrop and 5 Manchester, and in so doing shall have all the rights and be 6 subject to all the duties and liabilities of corporations exer-7 cising similar powers under the general laws of the state.

Sect. 2. The said company is authorized to make con-2 tracts with the towns of Winthrop and Manchester, and any 3 village corporation therein, and with corporations and in-4 habitants of said towns for the purpose of supplying light, 5 heat and power as contemplated by this act. The said 6 towns, through their selectmen, or any village corporation 7 therein through the assessors thereof, are severally author-8 ized to contract with the said company from time to time 9 for a supply of electricity for public purposes from year 10 to year or for a term of years, as they may deem expedient 11 and to raise money therefor.

Sect. 3. The said company for the purposes of this act 2 may increase its capital stock and issue the same therefor to 3 an amount not exceeding thirty thousand dollars.

Sect. 4. The said company may issue its bonds for the 2 purposes of this act from time to time and in such amount 3 and on such rates and time as it may deem expedient, and 4 secure the same by appropriate mortgages upon its property 5 and franchises.

Sect. 5. The locations of all posts, wires and fixtures 2 of the said corporation as now established and maintained 3 are hereby confirmed and made valid.

Sect. 6. This act shall take effect when approved.
