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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

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AN ACT to amend Chapter 97, Section 3, of the Revised  
Statutes, relating to bastard children and their maintenance.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section three of chapter ninety-seven of the Revised  
2 Statutes of Maine is hereby amended by adding after the  
3 last word in said section the following words: "The cost  
4 of commitment and board of the accused while so in jail  
5 shall be paid by the county in which said jail is situated.  
6 If he gives the required bond after commitment he shall be

7 liberated upon payment of said costs of commitment and  
8 board,” so that said section as amended shall read as  
9 follows :

‘Sect. 3. When the accused is brought before such or  
11 any other justice he may be required to give bond to the  
12 complainant, with sufficient sureties, in such reasonable  
13 sum as the justice orders, conditioned for his appearance  
14 at the next term of the supreme judicial or superior court  
15 for the county in which she resides, and for his abiding  
16 the order of the court thereon ; and if he does not give it  
17 he shall be committed to jail until he does. The cost of  
18 said commitment and board of the accused while so in jail  
19 shall be paid by the county in which said jail is situated.  
20 If he gives the required bond after said commitment he  
21 shall be liberated upon payment of cost of commitment and  
22 board.’
