STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend section three, chapter two hundred two
Public Laws of eighteen hundred eighty-nine entitled, "An
Act to fix the salaries of the judge and register of probate and
county commissioners of Waldo county."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section three, chapter two hundred two, Public
2 Laws of eighteen hundred eighty-nine is hereby amended by
3 striking out section three and insert in the place thereof the
4 following:

'Sect. 3. On and after the first day of February, nineteen
6 hundred and three the pay of the county commissioners of
7 Waldo county shall be two dollars and fifty cents per day

8 for each day actually employed in the service of said county,
9 including time spent in traveling for which each commis-
10 sioner shall have ten cents per mill for the distance actually
11 traveled, but, each commissioner shall have no more than one
12 travel during the same hearing, or session, or for more than
13 two adjournments of any regular term or for services or
14 travel on more than one petition or case at the same time or
15 anything for travel or attendance at the legislature, connected
16 with the annual county estimates, or for any additional
17 trouble or expense.'

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this
2 act are hereby repealed.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
