STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Bangor and Brewer Steam
Ferry Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The charter of the Bangor and Brewer Steam
2 Ferry Company, with all the rights and privileges and all the
3 responsibilities attaching to said company by virtue of the
4 several acts creating, extending and relating thereto, shall
5 continue and remain in force for twenty years from the
6 eighth day of February, A. D. 1903.

Provided, however, that said company shall run its boats
8 each day during the season from 5.30 o'clock in the morning,

9 until 11 o'clock at night; and shall properly light its ferry
10 slips, so long as its boats shall run; and also light the
11 approaches to the ice, in the winter.

Sect. 2. Said corporation shall have the right to collect a
2 toll of five cents for each passenger carried upon its boats,
3 after 9 o'clock in the evening; instead of the toll established
4 by its original charter.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
