## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend an act incorporating the trustees of Coburn Classical Institute.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section two of chapter three hundred thirty-
- 2 three of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred
- 3 and one is hereby amended by striking out of the second line
- 4 thereof the word "seventeen" and inserting in its place the
- 5 word 'twenty' so that said section two, as amended shall read:
  - 'Sect. 2. Said corporation shall be governed and its powers
- 7 exercised by a board of not exceeding twenty trustees, of
- 8 which the president of Colby College and the principal of
- 9 Coburn Classical Institute for the time being shall, ex-officio,
- 10 be members. At the organization of the corporation, the

11 number of other trustees shall be fixed by the by-laws and 12 shall be divided as nearly as may be into three classes; one 13 class shall be elected for one year, one for two years and one 14 for three years; and at each annual meeting thereafter, mem-15 bers shall be elected by the board in place of those who terms 16 shall expire, and any vacancies in the other classes shall be 17 filled.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
