IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

---

AN ACT to amend chapter six hundred and thirteen of the  
Private and Special Laws of 1893, entitled "An Act to  
establish the Western Hancock Municipal Court."

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section nine of chapter six hundred and  
2 thirteen of the Private and Special Laws of 1893 is hereby  
3 amended by striking out the words "On the fourth Tues-  
4 day of each of the months of May, July, September and  
5 November in the town of Deer Isle" and inserting in  
6 place thereof the words 'On the fourth Tuesday of each  
7 of the months of January, February, March, April, May,  
8 July, September, October, November and December in  
9 the town of Deer Isle' so that said section as amended  
10 shall read as follows:

‘Sect. 9. A term of said court shall be held for the  
12 transaction of civil business as follows: On the second  
13 Tuesday of each of the months of January, March, July  
14 and September in the town of Bluehill. On the second  
15 Tuesday of each of the months of February, May, June,  
16 August, November and December in the town of Bucks-  
17 port. On the fourth Tuesday of each of the months of  
18 January, February, March, April, May, July, September,  
19 October, November and December in the town of Deer  
20 Isle. On the fourth Tuesday of the months of June and  
21 August in the town of Castine. Beginning at ten o’clock  
22 in the forenoon at such place in either of the towns named  
23 in this section, as the judge shall determine. For the  
24 cognizance and trial of criminal actions said court shall be  
25 considered in constant session. In all cases it may be  
26 adjourned from time to time by the judge.’

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
