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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

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AN ACT to incorporate Union Power Company.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Deola C. Getchell, George C. Cary, Edward  
2 E. Talbot with their associates, successors and assigns, are  
3 hereby made a corporation under the name of Union Power  
4 Company, for the purpose of manufacturing, generating,  
5 selling, leasing, transmitting, distributing and supplying  
6 electricity for heating, manufacturing and mechanical pur-  
7 poses, in the towns of Machias and Machiasport.

Sect. 2. Said corporation for the purposes aforesaid is  
2 hereby authorized to set poles and to construct, lay,

3 maintain and operate lines of wires or other material in,  
4 through, under, over and along any and all streets and  
5 ways of said towns, and under or over tide waters in said  
6 towns, subject, however, to the permission of the municipi-  
7 pal officers thereof and under such reasonable restrictions  
8 as they may impose and subject to the general laws of  
9 the state regulating the erection of poles and wires for  
10 electrical purposes.

Sect. 3. The capital stock of said company shall not  
2 exceed fifty thousand dollars, divided into shares of the par  
3 value of one hundred dollars each.

Sect. 4. Said company is hereby authorized to issue  
2 its bonds for the construction of its works upon such rates  
3 and terms as it may deem expedient, and secure the same  
4 by mortgage of the franchise and property of said com-  
5 pany. But the amount of said bonds so issued shall not  
6 exceed fifty thousand dollars in all, and shall not exceed  
7 the amount of capital stock subscribed for.

Sect. 5. The first meeting of said company may be  
2 called by written notice thereof, signed by any incorporator  
3 herein named, serving upon each incorporator by a copy  
4 of the same in hand or mailed, postage paid, at least seven  
5 days prior to the day named therein for such meeting.

Sect. 6. This act shall become null and void in two  
2 years from the time when the same takes effect, unless the  
3 corporation shall have organized and commenced the con-  
4 struction of its works under this charter.

Sect. 7. This act shall take effect when approved.
