STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to prevent pollution of the waters of Sebago Lake.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. No person or corporation shall use or occupy
- 2 any structure hereafter built upon or near the shores of
- 3 Sebago lake in the county of Cumberland, or upon any of the
- 4 islands of said lake, for such purposes or in such manner that
- 5 the sewage or drainage therefrom shall enter the waters of
- 6 said lake or pollute the same.
- Sect. 2. No sewage, drainage, refuse or polluting matter
- 2 of such kind and amount as either by itself or in connection
- 3 with other matter will corrupt or impair the quality of the

- 4 water of said Sebago lake, or render it injurious to health, 5 shall be discharged into said lake, but nothing herein shall 6 prohibit the cultivation and use of the soil in the ordinary 7 methods of agriculture if no human excrement is used 8 thereon within three hundred feet of the shores of said lake.
- Sect. 3. The supreme judicial court shall have jurisdiction 2 in equity to enjoin, prevent or restrain any violation of the 3 provisions of this act.
 - Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
