AN ACT to extend the charter of the Ellsworth Street Railway Company.


Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Ells2 worth Street Railway Company which were granted by
3 chapter 391 of the Private and Special Laws for the year
4 1889, as extended and enlarged by chapter 515 of the Private
5 and Special Laws for the year 1893, chapter 81 of the Pri6 vate and Special Laws for the year 1895, chapter 456 of the
7 Private and Special Laws for the year 1897, chapter 133 of
8 the Private and Special Laws for the year 1899, and chapter

9 267 of the Private and Special Laws for the year 1901, are

10 hereby extended for two years additional, and the persons
11 named in said acts, their associates and successors, shall have
12 the rights, powers and privileges that were granted to them
13 by said acts to be exercised by them for the same purposes as
14 specified in said acts.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
