STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT extending the charter and changing the name of the
Van Buren Trust and Banking Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Chapter two hundred and seventy-six of the Pri-
vate and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-five
entitled "An Act to incorporate the Van Buren Trust and
Banking Company," as amended by chapter one hundred and
thirty-one of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hun-
dred and ninety-nine, as extended by chapter three hundred
and thirty-seven of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen

8 hundred and one is hereby continued in force and the persons
9 named in said act, as amended, are hereby given a period of
10 two years from the date of the approval of this act in which
11 to organize and commence business.

Sect. 2. The name of the Van Buren Trust and Banking
2 Company is hereby changed to Van Buren Trust Company.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
