STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter 215 of the Resolves of the State of
Maine of 1897 relating to tuition of students in agriculture at
University of Maine.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

That said chapter 215 of the resolves of the State of Maine
2 of 1897, is hereby amended by adding to the same the words
3 'and to students pursuing the courses in agriculture,' so that
4 said section as amended shall read as follows:

'That said trustees are hereby directed to charge all students
6 a reasonable tuition but they may abate said tuition to such
7 worthy pupils resident in the State as may be financially
8 unable to pay the same, and to students pursuing the courses
9 in agriculture.'
