STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the town of Sanford.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the school fund for the
2 year one thousand nine hundred and two to the town of
3 Sanford, the sum of eight hundred fifty-nine dollars and
4 twenty-three cents, being the amount due said town, on
5 account of its failure to make its annual return, by reason of
6 sickness of its superintendent.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This resolve is introduced to authorize the treasurer of State to pay over to the town of Sanford, ten per cent of its school money, which was withheld on account of the failure of the superintendent of schools to make his returns within the time required by law, by reason of his sickness.
