IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THREE.

---

AN ACT in relation to the Trustees of Westbrook Seminary.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Women shall be eligible to membership on the  
2 board of trustees of Westbrook Seminary, which board shall  
3 consist of not less than three nor more than twenty-seven  
4 members to be elected by the board as heretofore and hold  
5 office for the term of six years, vacancies by death, resigna-  
6 tion or otherwise to be filled by election of members for the  
7 unexpired term. Not more than one-third of the number  
8 shall be clergymen, and eight members shall constitute a  
9 quorum if there are more than fifteen members, but if less  
10 a majority shall be a quorum.

Sect. 2. The election and qualifications of the present and  
2 all past acting members of the board of trustees and all their  
3 acts and doings in their official capacity are hereby con-  
4 firmed, legalized and made valid.
