STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT relating to the Camden Trotting Park Association.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Camden Trotting Park Association, a corporation organized under the general laws of the State of Maine, and located at Camden, in the county of Knox, shall have and exercise all the powers, rights and privileges granted to and exercised by agricultural societies and similar corporations.

Sect. 2. Said corporation shall have all the police powers, together with all other powers and privileges, at all of its exhibitions of whatever name and nature, which are conferred upon agricultural societies by sections sixteen, seventeen and eighteen of chapter fifty-eight of the Revised Statutes.

Sect. 3. The prohibitions, restrictions, forfeitures, and
2 penalties provided by section nineteen of chapter fifty-eight
3 of the Revised Statutes, shall be applicable to all exhibitions
4 of said corporation.

Sect. 4. Whoever, contrary to the regulations of said cor-
2 poration, shall enter or pass within the enclosure of its
3 exhibition or fair grounds, shall forfeit to such corporation
4 a sum not exceeding five dollars, to be recovered on com-
5 plaint.

Sect. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
