STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of Sebacook Manufacturing
and Power Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. That the rights, powers and privileges of the
2 Sebacook Manufacturing and Power Company, which
3 were granted by chapter eighty-six of the Private and Special
4 Laws of one thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine and
5 extended for the term of two years by chapter four hundred
6 seventeen of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hun-
7 dred one, are hereby further extended for and during a term
8 of two years from the date of the approval of this act, with
9 the exception of the right to manufacture, generate, sell, dis-

10 tribute and supply electricity for lighting purposes in the
11 town of Clinton. And the persons named in said act, their
12 associates and successors, shall have all the rights, powers
13 and privileges that were granted them thereby to be exercised
14 in the same manner and for the same purposes as specified
15 therein, except as modified by this act.

Sect. 2. Said company is also authorized to engage in man-
2 ufacturing with all the rights and powers and subject to all
3 the restrictions and liabilities incident to manufacturing cor-
4 porations under the laws of this State.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
