STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT relative to the Clinton Electric Light and Power
Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Clinton Electric Light and Power Com-
2 pany, a corporation organized under the general laws of the
3 State of Maine, is hereby authorized to make, generate, sell,
4 distribute and supply gas and electricity for lighting, heating,
5 manufacturing and mechanical purposes in the town of
6 Clinton.

Sect. 2. The inhabitants of the town of Clinton are hereby
2 authorized to contract with said company for lighting said
3 town for such time and upon such terms as they may by vote
4 determine.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
