STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and fifty-two of the Public Laws of 1895, relating to State Examination and Certification of Teachers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Chapter one hundred and fifty-two of the 2 public laws of 1895 is hereby amended by inserting after 3 the word "examination" in the third line of section four 4 of said chapter the words 'and certification,' so that said 5 section, as amended, shall read as follows:
- 'Sect. 4. The certificates issued under the provisions 7 of this act shall be accepted by school committees, super-8 visors and superintendents in lieu of the personal examina-

9 tion and certification required by section eighty-seven, 10 chapter eleven, of the revised statutes and all amendments 11 thereto.'

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with 2 this act are hereby repealed.
