STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and forty-five of
the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and
eighty-seven, entitled “An Act to provide sewerage in the
town of Houlton.”

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section two of said act is hereby amended to read as
2 follows :

‘Sect. 2. Said corporation may acquire and hold real
4 and personal estate necessary and convenient for the pur-
5 poses aforesaid, not exceeding in amount one hundred
6 thousand dollars; may sell and convey the same; may

7 issue certificates of stock to an amount not exceeding the
8 amount of its capital stock actually paid in; and may
9 issue and sell bonds to an amount not exceeding fifty
10 thousand dollars, to aid in the construction, repairs and
11 improvements of its works, and said bonds to the amount
12 of fifty thousand dollars may be purchased and held by
13 the savings banks of Maine.'
