
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT to authorize the town of Kennebunk to own and maintain an Electric Lighting and Power Plant.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The town of Kennebunk is hereby author2 ized to acquire, own, and maintain an electric lighting and
3 power plant, and for such purpose said town is vested
4 with power to raise money at its annual meeting, or at
5 any legal meeting called for the purpose, for the purchase
6 or lease of lands, water power, dams, manufactories and
7 works for providing and supplying electricity, and for
8 the purchase of dynamos and other apparatus necessary
9 for equipping and properly maintaining an electric light10 ing and power plant.

- Sect. 2. Said town is also authorized to construct, lay, 2 maintain and support lines of wire or other material for 3 the transmission of electricity upon, under, along and 4 over any and all streets and roads within the limits of said 5 town, and for such purpose to erect, establish and main-6 tain in and along said streets and roads all necessary 7 poles, pipes and apparatus; provided that said poles, 8 pipes and apparatus are so erected, established and main-9 tained as not to unreasonably interfere with the public 10 use of said streets and roads.
- Sect. 3. Said town is also authorized to use the 2 electricity by it manufactured and generated to light its 3 streets, roads and public squares, and all buildings or parts 4 of buildings owned, used or occupied by it, and said town 5 is further authorized to sell, distribute and furnish electricity for lighting and power to individuals and corporations.
- Sect. 4. Said town is further authorized to purchase 2 or lease the rights, privileges, properties and franchises of 3 any corporation organized for furnishing electricity for 4 lighting or power within the territory of said town, and 5 such corporation is hereby empowered to sell, transfer, 6 convey or lease its rights, privileges, properties and 7 franchises to said town.
 - Sect. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
