STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THREE.

AN ACT relating to the salary of the Sheriff of the county
of Aroostook, and fixing the same at five hundred dollars
a year.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The salary of the Sheriff of the county of
2 Aroostook shall be five hundred dollars a year, instead of
3 the sum now fixed by law, said salary to be paid in equal
4 quarterly payments.

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with
2 this act, are hereby repealed.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect on the first day of
2 April, nineteen hundred and three.
